

COVID-19 Procedures

Due to the 2019-2020 outbreak of the Coronavirus (COVID-19), ESO Arts Center is taking extra precautions with the care of every client to include health history review and enhanced sanitation/disinfecting procedures in compliance with CDC guidance.

Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Dry Cough
- Difficulty Breathing

ESO is following theses enhanced procedures to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Some group classes may require that student's **temperatures be taken** before entering the classroom or studio.
- Masks are required in all common areas of the building. Depending on the
 activity masks may be taken down in your workspace and put back on before
 exiting the building, using the restroom, etc.
- There should be **no materials shared**. Preferably, each student should bring their own materials which they take home.
- Teachers are responsible to **clean and disinfect** the classroom points of contact after every use.
- Class numbers will be limited to accommodate for 6-10 ft per student. In small classrooms class numbers are limited to 10. In the large studio no more than 20 people are permitted in the space.
- Everyone should frequently wash and sanitize their hands.
- Parents waiting for their children should avoid entering the building. A coned off drop-off and pick-up zone is in the front of the building, Please, do not park in front loop. ESO Has a free public broadband Wi-Fi connection that is best reached from your car on the west side of the building (near the side field.)
- If there is any doubt refer to the CDC recommended guidelines.
